8. Mr.Clayton.
9. Miss M.Walker.

3. The band will then play a Fanfare followed by "The Queen", and afterwards Mr.Dineley will welcome the parents, staff and pupils, and then ask the Headmaster (Mr.Armishaw) to introduce the opener (Mr.W.B.Simms). Mr.Simms will open the Garden Party, and then the Chairman (Mr.Dineley) will ask Mr.Howard Robinson to thank the opener (Mr.W.B.Simms)
4. The Chairman will then ask those present to remain seated and the official party will leave the platform and take up places in the same order in the seats provided on the front row.
5. The band will then strike up with "Pomp and Circumstance" march, and the school choir will lead the singing of "Land of Hope and Glory".
