I started at Cheadle Moseley in September 1975, having passed my 11+ at Etchells Primary School in Heald Green, which was the same month that Henry Curry became Headmaster. Mr Armishaw had given the presentation to parents and new pupils in the July as the outgoing Headmaster, so I did see him.
