SCHOOL RULES

1. Pupils are subject to the Headmaster's jurisdiction during school hours and whilst travelling to and from school.
2. All instructions given to pupils by members of staff will be considered as instructions from the Headmaster.
3. All pupils will obey instructions given by prefects who are appointed by and responsible to the Headmaster.
4. Pupils failing to obey the Headmaster's rules concerning movement within the school or whose conduct is unseemly will be punished.
5. Pupils failing to attend punctually or failing to complete and hand in homework at the proper time will be detained on the day in question.
6. All absence must be accounted for by a letter from the parent to be submitted on the day of return.
7. Absence for reasons other than sickness is forbidden unless permission has been obtained from the Headmaster.
8. Any pupil who is unfit for P.T. or Games on a particular day must produce a note to this effect from his parent at morning registration on the day in question.
9. Pupils suffering from any contagious disease are not allowed in school and should submit a medical certificate of fitness before returning to school.
10.
 - a. School uniform will be worn at all times in school, when travelling to and from school, and by pupils representing the school at any place.
 - b. All articles of clothing, books and personal property must be clearly marked with the owner's name.
11. Pupils must be suitably dressed for Physical Training and Games.
12. Text books and apparatus issued to individual pupils are, and remain, the property of the school. Loss or damage must be made good by replacement or payment.
13. Wilful damage to school buildings or furniture will be the subject of an enquiry and an official claim will be forwarded to the parent of any pupil responsible.
14.
 - a. No pupil may enter the school out of normal hours.
 - b. No pupil may enter the premises before the first bell of the day—normally at 8-30 a.m.
 - c. No pupil may remain on the school premises after the official closing time—normally at 4 p.m.—unless in the charge of a member of staff.
 - d. No pupil may leave the school premises during normal school hours without permission from a member of staff.
15. It is forbidden to bring to school any articles that may cause injury to persons.
16. Personal property is the responsibility of the individual.
17. The borrowing of bicycles, articles of clothing, P.T. and games kit, books, etc., is forbidden.
18. The school field may be used only at specified times. The brook and its bank are out of bounds.
19. The normal punishment for pupils breaking school rules is detention. Persistent breaking of rules, persistently unreasonable conduct or any serious misdemeanour may result in suspension from school.
20. The Headmaster may vary or add to the above rules from time to time and will give due notice to the school of any amendment or addition.
